#### INTRODUCTION

The Fund has been established at Karachi and is registered under the Voluntary Social Welfare Agencies (Registration and Control) Ordinance, 1961 (XLVI of 1961) on March 12, 1989. The objects of the Fund are to provide help in the shape of medical, social, vocational and physical rehabitational assistance to the poor who are neurologically disabled, to improve neurology patients' welfare by increasing knowledge of physicians in the diseases of the nervous system, to support the research projects in these diseases, to acquire teaching aids equipment and to provide complete library facilities. The Fund is operating at Department of Neurology, Jinnah Postgraduate Medical Centre; and Karachi

### SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### **Basis of Preparation**

- 2.1.1 These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the generally accepted accounting rules & procedures as applicable in Pakistan. These comprise of International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) as notified under the Companies Act, 2017. Acounting Standards for Not for Profit Organisations issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan as notified under the Companies Act, 2017
- 2.1.2 These financial statements are presented in Pakistani Rupees, which is the organisation/ fund's functional currency.

### 2.2 Accounting Convention

These financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

## 2.3 Income Recognition

Income is recognized to the extent it is possible that economic benefits will flow to the organization and where it can be measured reliabily. Income is recognized at fair value on Receipt basis.

#### 2.4 Inventory

Inventories comprise medicines, consumables and surgical supplies. These are valued at lower of cost and net realizeable value. Cost is determined on the Weighted Average Cost basis.
